Preservation Briefs - Technical Preservation Services ...
Choosing an appropriate treatment for a historic building or landscape is critical. Preservation may be appropriate if distinctive materials, features, and spaces are essentially intact and convey the building's historical significance. If the building requires more extensive repair and replacement, or if alterations or additions are necessary for a new use, then Rehabilitation is probably the most appropriate treatment.

An Overview of Historic Preservation
Recognizing the need to protect such architecture, Congress enacted the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) in 1966. It basically requires the existence and continuance of historic buildings for the public benefit and heritage.
